Purpose:	Psycholinguistic assessment of language processing in a person with acquired aphasia
Short description:	PALPA is a comprehensive test battery for aphasia assessing. It provides the opportunity to go into depth in some language areas to find out what is most appropriate to work with. The test battery consists of approx. 60 sub-tests. It is not the meaning to give the whole battery to a person, but to select a few relevant sub-tests in each case
