

Name	PYRAMIDE- og PALMETESTEN (PYPAT)/ PYRAMIDE AND PALM TEST
Purpose:	To describe and assess aphasia
Short description:	The test examines person's access to semantic knowledge using words and images. PYPAT consists of 52 tasks where each task has three paragraphs consisting of pictures and words. Speech therapists can choose to use the test in six different ways, depending on what they want to test
