Short description:	BPVS is abbreviation for British Picture Vocabulary Scale. One of the uses of the BPVS-II is to assess children for whom English is an additional language (EAL). This test is useful for assessing the understanding of vocabulary in EAL children, since it does not require the production of words, only their recognition
