

Name	PPVT-4 (PEABODY PICTURE VOCABULARY TEST)
Purpose:	Test for the assessment of receptive vocabulary in children and adults
Short description:	PPVT-4 is a classic test for the assessment of receptive vocabulary. The test tasks consist of images, and the test person is instructed to point to the image that best matches the stimulus word the test leader verbally gives. The tasks are arranged in 19 blocks with 12 tasks in each. The blocks have increasing difficulty and only the blocks corresponding to the person's current vocabulary are provided. The test time is thus relatively short. Form B is a parallel version with similar but new items. Two parallel forms for more accurate retesting
