Purpose:	Screening tool for assessment of ADHD problems
Short description:	Brown Attention-Deficit Disorder Scales consists of two questionnaires. One for the age range 12–18 years and one for 18 years and up. Brown ADD Scales is a user-friendly and effective test that can be administered within 10-20 minutes. The scale can be used as a screening instrument, as part of a more extensive investigation or to assess the effects of treatment. The forms contain 40 statements each and can be administered to individuals over 12 years of age
