

Name	NORDISK OROFACIAL TEST-SCREENING (NOT-2)
Purpose:	NOT-S is used in case of difficulty with speech, chewing or swallowing
Short description:	Nordic Orofacial Test-Screening (NOT-S) is a protocol used for suspected speech, chewing and swallowing problems from the age of three. The screening is performed through an interview and an examination. It takes about 10 minutes to complete. In addition to oral instructions, an image manual is used to illustrate how the tasks are to be performed
