

Name	AMSLER CHART MANUAL
Purpose:	A tool for visual screening purposes. It has been designed to disclose changes in the macular and foveal areas which may difficult, or in some cases impossible, to detect by other means
Short description:	The test consists of a manual with 7 different charts for visual field testing. The charts consist of a fixing point and a grid pattern. One eye is covered while the other is being tested. Anyone who is going to take a test must focus on the fixation point and describe what happens with the routing pattern around. The test person is required to be cooperative and able to describe what is happening
